Open Class Entry Instructions

K-12 student artists that do not have the School Select option, or did not qualify through the School Select program, are invited to submit art for consideration through Open Class Selection. Open Class is juried by two professional artists selected by the directors of the EAF Student Art Exhibit.

May 20-24	Notifications of juried selection and delivery instructions
June 3	Accepted Artwork Delivery deadline
June 17-19	Festival

ELIGIBILITY

Students must be in grades K-12 and one of the following must apply:

- be currently enrolled in the Edmonds School District
- be currently enrolled in a private school within the District boundaries
- home-schooled or a resident within the Edmonds School District boundaries

Elementary (grades K-6): Limit 1 piece per student (school select or open class)

Secondary (grades 7-12): Limit 2 pieces total per student (school select and/or open class)

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

On-line registrations:

Online registrations are accepted April 27-May 6. An ESD student email account, or Google Mail account must be used to register and upload a photo of the artwork.

Visit www.EdmondsArtsFestival.com and select **APPLY** to reach the Student Art Exhibit registration link. The link will be active April 27-May 6, 2022.

Open Class jury results and further instructions will be sent during the third week in May.

CRITERIA

The Exhibit will accept:

2-D Art: Watercolor, Pen & Ink, Photography, Paper, Tempera, Pencil, Acrylic, Print Making, Mixed Media, Digital, Other. 2-D work may not exceed 24"x36" Stretched canvas must have wire hangers.

3-D Art: Ceramics, Glass, Mosaic, Fiber, Wood, Paper Mache', Metal, Other. 3-D work may not exceed 80"hx-30"x30". Large pieces— Make prior arrangements.

Not Accepted:

- Modeling clay artwork
- Lego or kit creations
- Works considered too fragile for transport/installation
- Collaborative/group projects
- Glass frames
- Saw tooth hangers

Artwork considered for the ESD calendar must

- include correct spelling
- not include images of licensed characters

AWARDS

Approximately 35 Top Honor Awards will be awarded by two professional artist jurors. One piece of artwork will be selected by the Student Art Directors to be the Student Art Poster for 2022. These honors will be awarded cash prizes. Awards will be acknowledged at the Festival.

Edmonds School District will choose approximately 40 works to be included in the 2022-23 calendar.
